Dear player/parent,

Welcome to Elmden Rovers Youth Football Club 2023-2024 season.

At Elmden football club we have teams from under 7's and above. We believe that promoting fun is just as important as playing in a competitive sport. There are too many people that think winning is a must, but suffer on the enjoyment. At Elmden Rovers we realise that when your child is playing football it is their hobby so if they are not enjoying themselves then it becomes a chore. Each team has at least a level 1 coach and many are level 2 and First Aid trained so when we are training and at matches you know that we have the right people in place. All volunteers /coaches are also Enhanced DBS checked. We have a dedicated Child Welfare Officer (Mark Robinson) who ensures that we meet all the requirements that the law states for your child's welfare. We promote that each team has a parent representative who can attend our monthly meetings to see how the club is run and bring any ideas or concerns other parents may have. This season 2023-2024 we have been a Charter Standard club for 13 years now and this proves that Elmden Rovers will comply and promote youth football and this is why the players/parents/coaches and managers together with volunteers read and abide by the Respect and Code of Conduct documentation on the website.

There is a sign on fee for new players but existing Elmden Rovers players sign on is free this year. A monthly fee of £25 for 12 months is to cover line marking pitches, cutting pitches, referees, training lights. First aid equipment, training equipment, balls and the training pitch hire in the winter months.

All Match and Training kit provided by the club shall be looked after at all times and returned to the club if for any reason you leave the team.

We have a website where the teams each have their own page but this does require volunteers from each team to update each week after games or just with news or forums. We also have the Elmden Rovers YFC Twitter page. If you can help in any way from being a parent rep or just helping with our presentations or fund raising then please speak to your manager as we can never have enough help!
